



The Mission Project enables capable adults with developmental or cognitive disabilities to live independently and safely in community with minimal support.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- The first participant moved into an apartment in Mission in the summer of 2004. As of Spring 2010, the project had 15 participants living in Mission.
- Families have access to employment specialists from a licensed agency, whom they can hire to develop jobs and provide job training and ongoing counseling for their participant.
- Families have access to independent living services, for which they can contract with licensed providers for independent living skills training and support for their participant.
- Volunteers answer a 24-hour Help Line to provide support and respond to emergencies.
- Mission's Sylvester Powell Jr. Community Center provides participants with ongoing opportunities for fitness and recreation.
- Johnson County Community College's extension program offers classes geared to participants' learning needs.
- Participants engage in varied social activities designed to promote friendships and build community.
- Participants have opportunities to attend cultural events, such as plays, exhibits and concerts, regularly. They also have access to acting and ballroom dance lessons.
- The Mission Project Travel Club teaches participants about other places, such as St. Louis and Chicago, before they visit.
- Aktion Club, a Kiwanis Club project, fosters leadership skills and provides opportunities for serving others.
- A weekly Problem Solvers group enables participants to improve social skills and learn how to optimize relationships within the community.

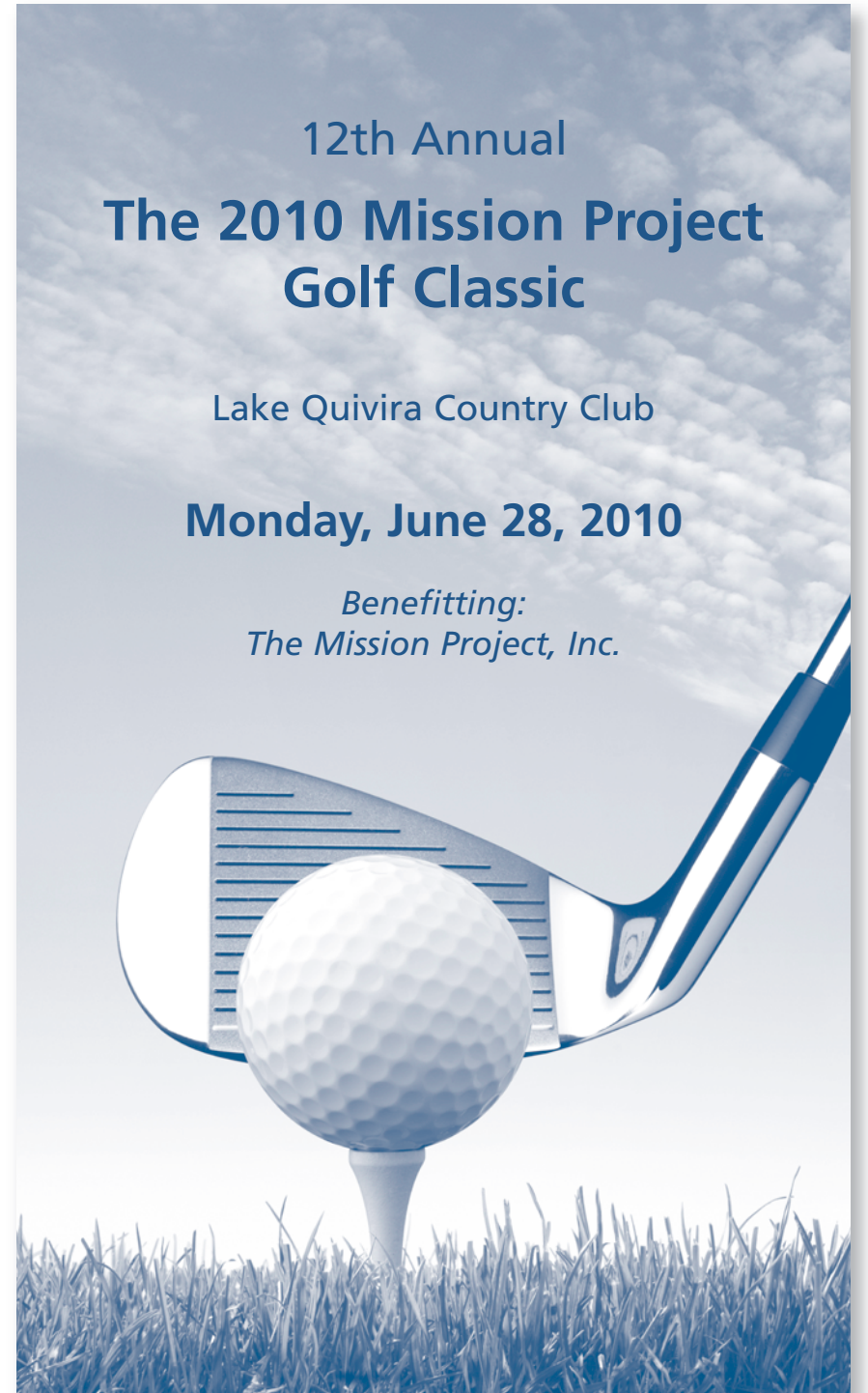
